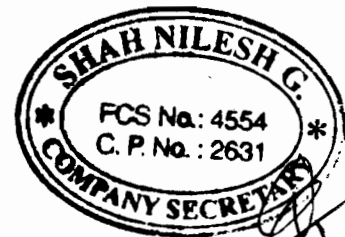

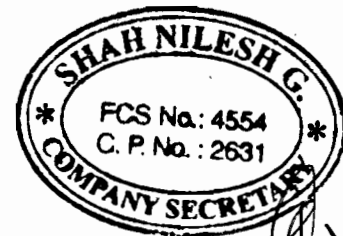

My responsibility as a scrutinizer for the postal ballot voting process and e-voting process is restricted to ensure that the voting process is conducted in a fair and transparent manner and make a Scrutinizer's report of the votes cast "in favour" or "against" the resolution stated above, based on the reports generated from the postal ballots received from the shareholders and e-voting system provided by the National Securities Depository Limited ('NSDL'), the authorized agency to provide e-voting facilities, engaged by the Company.


